Tachikawa School G Pen

Dear Customer,

Thank you for purchasing an Inkursive pen, I hope it gives you many years of valuable use. I have made some notes below to help you get the best out of it.

This pen is not intended for use by children under the age of 14. In case of any issues, please contact me first as I may be able to rectify the problem.

Features:


- Flexible Nib Fountain Pen for Calligraphy, Manga and Art
- Cartridge with pigment ink included
- Lightweight
- Syringe and blunt applicator included

Filling

The pen comes with an ink cartridge in the barrel. Unscrew the nib unit and shake to get the cartridge out.

To install the cartridge, hold the nib unit with the nib down and push firmly.

Use



The nib is perfect for drawing detail and fine lines, it is a firm flexible nib suitable for drawing different widths of lines. Use more pressure for a thicker line.

The nib is not 'tipped' so can be scratchy on some paper. Use art paper or other smooth high-quality paper.

This pen is intended for frequent use and can dry up if left unused for 1–2 weeks. If the pen does dry up, soak the nib in water to revive it. If the pen is left dried up for more than three weeks, it can become permanently clogged.

The pen is not covered by the warranty if ink has dried out on the nib.

Converting to 'eye-dropper' mode

Once the cartridge is empty the pen can be converted to 'eye-dropper' mode, where the body of the pen is filled with ink.

To do this:

- Unscrew the nib unit and remove the cartridge
- Screw the blunt needle onto the syringe. Note once installed the needle can't be removed.
- Using the syringe fill the body of the pen with ink to about 2cm from the threads.
- Screw the nib unit back on the pen firmly.

It is also possible to use the syringe to refill the cartridge.

In cold weather the pen may 'burp' where a drop of ink comes out of the nib when in use. If this happens, the cartridge can be refilled instead.

Use only fountain pen ink. Dip-pen ink may contain particles that can clog the feed.

Nano-pigment inks like R&K SketchINK or De Atramentis document inks can be used, but note that if left to dry out they may clog the nib.
